7 licenses and tags; and amending Sec. 3,

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 Section 1. Sec. 3, Art. II, Ch. 94, SLA 1959, is amended to  
13 read:

14 Sec. 3. EXPIRATION OF LICENSES AND TAGS. a. All  
15 licenses and tags required under this Article, except the  
16 visitor's special sport fishing license, [SHALL] expire at  
17 the close of the [31st DAY OF DECEMBER] 30th day of June  
18 following issuance.

19 b. Licenses issued after the 1st day of January, 1961,  
20 continue in force and effect until the 30th day of June,  
21 1962.

22 Sec. 2. Sec. 2, Art. III, Ch. 94, SLA 1959, is amended to  
23 read:

24 Sec. 2. EXPIRATION DATE FOR LICENSES. a. All licenses  
25 required under the provisions of this Article [SHALL] expire  
26 at the close of the [THIRTY-FIRST DAY OF DECEMBER] 30th day  
27 of June following their issuance, and shall be renewed  
28 annually thereafter upon application and payment of license  
29 fees required by this Article.

b. Licenses issued after the 1st day of January, 1961,
