6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to licenses for subsistence  
7 fishing; amending Art. II, Ch. 94, SLA 1959  
8 as last amended by Ch. 131, SLA 1960; and  
9 providing for an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 Section 1. Subsec. (5), Sec. 2, Art. II, Ch. 94, SLA 1959  
12 is amended to read:

13 (5) Resident hunting, trapping  
14 & sport fishing license . . . . . 15.00

15 Provided, however, that the above license may be  
16 obtained by the head of any family or one solely dependent  
17 upon himself for support for a fee of \$.25 upon proof pre-  
18 sented by the applicant that the applicant (1) is obtaining  
19 or has obtained during the immediately preceding six months,  
20 assistance under any state or federal welfare program to aid  
21 the indigent, or (2) has an annual income of less than  
22 \$800.00 for the year immediately preceding application [, OR  
23 (3) HAS HISTORICALLY BEEN DEPENDENT ON FISH AND GAME FOR  
24 SUBSISTENCE].

25 Sec. 2. Sec. 2, Art. II, Ch. 94, SLA 1959 as last amended  
26 by Secs. 7 through 13, Ch. 131, SLA 1960, is amended by adding a  
27 new Subsec. (17) to read:

28 (17) No license shall be required of any resident  
29 of this state who furnishes the Commissioner of Fish and Game
