6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the daily compensation
7 of temporary session employees of the
8 Legislature; repealing Ch. 6, SLA 1959; and
9 providing for an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 Section 1. RATE OF COMPENSATION. Temporary session employees
12 of the Legislature hired to accomplish the work of legislative
13 sessions shall be compensated on a daily basis as reported by
14 their immediate supervisors according to the following schedule:
