IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the annual salaries of heads of the principal executive departments; amending Sec. 1, Ch. 105, SLA 1959; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 1, Ch. 105, SLA 1959, is amended to read:

Section 1. The head of each principal executive department of the State of Alaska upon appointment and qualification as provided in the State Organization Act of 1959 shall receive an annual salary as may be established by the governor. The governor may raise the salary of the head of a principal department to a maximum not to exceed \$17,000.00 per annum. Unless otherwise directed by the governor each [SUCH] department head shall [NOT] receive a salary in [EXCESS OF] the amount set opposite the titles listed below:

Attorney General . . . . .	17,000.00
Commissioner of Revenue . . . . .	15,000.00
Commissioner of Education . . . . .	17,000.00
Commissioner of Health and Welfare . . . . .	17,000.00
Commissioner of Labor . . . . .	15,000.00
Commissioner of Commerce . . . . .	15,000.00
Adjutant General . . . . .	12,000.00
Commissioner of Natural Resources . . . . .	17,000.00
