SENATE BILL NO. 94

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act forbidding the importation of intoxicating liquors into the State of Alaska except through a wholesaler; seizure for violation; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. UNLAWFUL IMPORTATION. Importation of intoxicating liquors, including malt beverages and wines, into the State of Alaska shall be unlawful unless the same are purchased from, or consigned by, a wholesaler licensed to do business in the State of Alaska, and with the state excise tax paid or secured.

Sec. 2. SEIZURE FOR VIOLATION. Intoxicating liquors, including malt beverages and wines, brought into the State of Alaska in violation of this Act shall be seized wherever found by any state officer and impounded pending payment of excise tax and costs of seizure and storage, or until otherwise disposed of according to law.

Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
