SENATE BILL NO. 98

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act appropriating \$3,910.00 to the Office of the Governor for reimbursement of members of the Alaska National Guard Scout Battallions for expenses incurred during their participation in the presidential inauguration; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. The sum of \$3,910.00 is appropriated from the general fund to the Office of the Governor for reimbursement of members of the First and Second Scout Battallions, Alaska National Guard, for expenses incurred on their trip to and during their participation in the presidential inauguration in Washington, D.C., in January of 1961.

Sec. 2. This appropriation shall be distributed among individual members of the Scout Battallions on vouchers certified by the governor and based on individual claims approved by the Department of Military Affairs.

Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
