IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for nomination by petition of candidates for electors of president and vice-president of the United States; amending Sec. 5.53, Art V, Ch. 83, SLA 1960; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 5.53, Art. V, Ch. 83, SLA 1960 is amended by adding a subsection:

Sec. 5.53. REQUIRED NUMBER OF SIGNATURES FOR NATIONAL OF STATEWIDE OFFICE. a. Petitions for the nomination of candidates for the office of governor, secretary of state, United States senator and United States representative shall be signed by not less than 500 [1,000] qualified voters. Candidates for the office of governor and secretary of state must file jointly. The petition must be signed by qualified voters of 5 or more election districts.

b. Petitions for the nomination of candidates for electors of president and vice-president of the United States shall be signed by not less than 500 qualified voters. The petition must be signed by qualified voters of 5 or more election districts.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
