6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Fish and Game Code
7 of Alaska; amending Sec. 6 of Art. I,
8 Ch. 94, SLA 1959."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 Section 1. The first two paragraphs of Sec. 6, Art. I,
11 Ch. 94, SLA 1959 are amended to read as follows:

12 Sec. 6. THE BOARD OF FISH AND GAME: TENURE: POWERS.

13 There shall be a Board of Fish and Game composed of ten
14 [EIGHT] members having a general knowledge of the fish and
15 game resources of the State and selected without regard to
16 political affiliation or special interest. They shall be
17 United States citizens and residents of Alaska as herein
18 defined. The members of the Board shall be appointed by
19 the Governor, subject to confirmation by a majority of the
20 members of the Legislature in joint session.

21 Each shall serve a four-year term, provided that the
22 first members appointed hereunder shall serve as follows:
23 two members shall serve for one year, two for two years, two
24 for three years, and two for four years, respectively [.] ;
25 provided, that the ninth and tenth members appointed under
26 this Act shall serve terms of two and four years, respective-
27 ly. Initial terms shall date from the first of February
28 immediately preceding appointment. In case a vacancy shall
29 occur on the Board, the Governor shall fill the same by
