6 For an Act entitled: "An Act to prohibit and make it unlawful for
7 any person, firm or corporation to procure or
8 attempt to procure any telecommunication
9 service with the intent to defraud another of
10 the lawful charge therefor, by means of any
11 trick, deception or false representation or
12 tampering with facilities; providing a
13 penalty; and providing for an effective date."

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

15 Section 1. Any individual, corporation, or other person, who,
16 with intent to defraud or to aid and abet another to defraud any
17 individual, corporation, or other person, of the lawful charge, in
18 whole or in part, for any telecommunications service, shall obtain,
19 or attempt to obtain, or aid and abet another to obtain or to
20 attempt to obtain, any telecommunications service:

21 (1) By charging such service to an existing telephone
22 number or credit card number without the authority of the sub-
23 scriber thereto or the legitimate holder thereof; or,

24 (2) By charging such service to a nonexistent, false,
25 fictitious, or counterfeit telephone number or credit card number
26 or to a suspended, terminated, expired, canceled, or revoked
27 telephone number or credit card number; or,

28 (3) By use of a code, prearranged scheme, or other
29 similar stratagem or device whereby said person, in effect, sends

or receives information; or,

(4) By installing, rearranging, or tampering with any facilities or equipment, whether physically, inductively, acoustically, electronically; or,

(5) By any other trick, stratagem, impersonation, false pretense, false representation, false statement, contrivance, device, or means,

shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall, upon conviction thereof, be imprisoned not exceeding one year or fined not exceeding \$1,000, or both, in the discretion of the court.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
