SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to embalmers; repealing and re-enacting Sec. 11, Ch. 119, SLA 1949, as amended by Ch. 64, SLA 1959; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 11, Ch. 119, SLA 1949, as amended by Sec. 10, Ch. 64, SLA 1959, is repealed and re-enacted to read:

Sec. 11. EMBALMERS: EXAMINATION AND LICENSE. The Commissioner of Health and Welfare is responsible for promulgating rules and regulations establishing the minimum qualifications for embalmers and for the examination and licensing of persons qualified to act as embalmers in the state, and for authorizing the issuance of licenses in the state to persons duly licensed under the laws of any state of the United States to act as embalmers. Licenses to act as an embalmer shall be issued by the Department of Revenue only upon certification in writing from the Commissioner of Health and Welfare that the applicant is qualified. The annual license fee to act as an embalmer under the provisions of this section is \$75.00. Appropriations to the Department of Health and Welfare to carry out the purposes of this Act shall be included in the general appropriation bill.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
