IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the parole of prisoners;
amending Sec. 13, Ch. 81, SLA 1960; and pro-
viding for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 13, Ch. 81, SLA 1960 is amended to read:

Sec. 13. APPLICABILITY TO PERSONS ON PAROLE OR INCAR-
CERATED. The provisions of this Act shall apply to all per-
sons convicted and sentenced in the superior court and the
district magistrate courts of this state, and to all persons
convicted of a crime which was punishable under laws enacted
by the Alaska Territorial Legislature and who were convicted
and sentenced before Alaska became a state or before the
Alaska state court system was in operation [FROM THE EFFEC-
TIVE DATE OF THIS ACT].

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
