SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to removal of encumbered vehicles from the state; amending Subsec. (4), Sec. 9, Ch. 124, SLA 1951 as amended by Sec. 3, Ch. 59, SLA 1953; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Subsec. (4), Sec. 9, Ch. 124, SLA 1951 as amended by Sec. 3, Ch. 59, SLA 1953 is amended to read:

(4) REMOVAL OF VEHICLES FROM STATE [TERRITORY]. Any owner who removes or causes to be removed, in any manner, from the state [TERRITORY] any encumbered vehicle, which is subject to the provisions of this Act, without the notarized [WRITTEN] consent of the mortgagee or conditional vendor shall be guilty of a felony and upon conviction shall be punished by imprisonment in the penitentiary for not more than 2 years or by a fine of not more than Two Thousand (\$2,000) Dollars, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
