BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Subsec. (4), Sec. 9, Ch. 124, SLA 1951 as amended

by Sec. 3, Ch. 59, SLA 1953 is amended to read:

(4) REMOVAL OF VEHICLES FROM STATE [TERRITORY]. Any

15

owner who removes or causes to be removed, in any manner,

16

from the state [TERRITORY] any encumbered vehicle, which is

17

subject to the provisions of this Act, without the written

18

consent of the mortgagee or conditional vendor, notarized or

19

attested to by two witnesses, shall be guilty of a felony and

20

upon conviction shall be punished by imprisonment in the peni-

21

tentiary for not more than 2 years or by a fine of not more

22

than Two Thousand (\$2,000) Dollars, or by both such fine and

23

imprisonment.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage

25

and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
