Section 1. Subsec. (2), Sec. 22, Ch. 173, SLA 1959 is amended

(2) [THE SECOND OFFENSE OF DRIVING] Driving a motor vehicle while under the influence of intoxicating liquor or a narcotic drug to a degree which renders him incapable of safely driving a motor vehicle. [, EITHER UNDER THIS ACT OR CHAPTER 107, SLA 1955;] The period of revocation shall be:

(a) First conviction, 30 days.

(b) Second conviction, one year.

(c) Third or subsequent conviction, three years.
