SENATE BILL NO. 130

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to registration plates for motor vehicles; amending Subsec. (9), Sec. 3, Ch. 124, SLA 1951 as amended by Ch. 50, SLA 1953; amending Subsec. (10), Sec. 3, Ch. 124, SLA 1951; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Subsec. (9), Sec. 3, Ch. 124, SLA 1951 as amended by Sec. 3, Ch. 50, SLA 1953 is amended to read:

(9) REGISTRATION PLATE [PLATES]: ISSUANCE. Upon registering a vehicle hereunder, the commissioner shall issue to the owner thereof one registration plate for every motor vehicle, [A] motorcycle, trailer, or semi-trailer, [AND TWO REGISTRATION PLATES FOR EVERY OTHER MOTOR VEHICLE,] which plates shall be issued to the particular vehicle registered and shall not be removed therefrom during the term for which said plates were issued or used upon any other vehicle, except as otherwise herein provided. Every registration plate shall have displayed on it the registration number assigned to the vehicle for which it is issued, the name of this state [TERRITORY], and the year for which such plate is issued; provided, however, that the commissioner may in his discretion select permanent registration plates consisting of a main plate and a yearly insert plate bearing the last two

numbers of the year for which such license is issued, in which event the main plate shall be and remain with the vehicle as long as it is required to be registered in the state [TERRITORY], and the yearly insert plate shall remain with the vehicle for the period of registration; provided, further, that special plates for mobile amateur radio stations, issued under Section 7 of this Act, shall have displayed on them the Federal Communications Commission call letters of the owner, in lieu of the registration number.

Sec. 2. Subsec. (10), Sec. 3, Ch. 124, SLA 1951 is amended to read:

(10) DISPLAY PLATES. [REGISTRATION PLATES ISSUED FOR A MOTOR VEHICLE OTHER THAN A MOTORCYCLE, TRAILER OR SEMI-TRAILER SHALL BE ATTACHED THERETO, ONE IN THE FRONT AND THE OTHER IN THE REAR.] The registration plates issued for a motor vehicle, motorcycle, trailer, or semi-trailer shall be attached to the rear thereof.

Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
