SENATE BILL NO. 132

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the leasing of space for state purposes; amending Sec. 8, Art. IV, Ch. 82, SLA 1955 as added by Ch. 81, SLA 1959; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 8, Art. IV, Ch. 82, SLA 1955 as added by Sec. 1, Ch. 81, SLA 1959, is amended to read:

Sec. 8. LEASES. The Purchasing Agent is hereby authorized and directed to lease necessary space, and contract for the lease of space for the use of the state or any agency or branch thereof, wherever it is necessary and feasible; subject, however, to full compliance with the preceding requirements of this article. The Purchasing Agent may lease the space for any period of time not exceeding 20 years but any lease shall be subject to the availability of appropriated funds for such lease payments. Any agency, authority, branch office, bureau or office of the state requiring office, warehouse or other space for state purposes and uses, shall lease such space solely through the Purchasing Agent.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
