6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the incorporation of
7 cities of the fourth class; amending Sec. E
8 3, Ch. 150, SLA 1957; and providing for
9 and effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 Section 1. Sec. 3, Ch. 150, SLA 1957 is amended to read:

12 Sec. 3. VILLAGES AUTHORIZED TO INCORPORATE. Any pro-
13 posed village that (1) is not included in, part of, or
14 within ten miles of [,] any incorporated city, or within
15 five miles of any independent school district [OR PUBLIC
16 UTILITY DISTRICT], and (2) has twenty-five or more permanent
17 inhabitants 19 [21] years of age or older residing within a
18 radius of three miles of a designated centrally located
19 point or structure, may form an incorporated village in the
20 manner hereinafter provided.

21 Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
22 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
