IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the salaries of state employees; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Each employee of the state whose salary as set out in the pay plan put into effect by executive order according to the provisions of Ch. 144, SLA 1960, is less than \$550 per month shall receive a pay increase in the amount of 10 per cent of the base salary he receives under the pay plan.

Sec. 2. Each employee of the state whose salary as set out in the pay plan put into effect by executive order according to the provisions of Ch. 144, SLA 1960, is \$550 but less than \$900 per month shall receive a pay increase in the amount of 6 per cent of the base salary he receives under the pay plan.

Sec. 3. Each employee of the state whose salary as set out in the pay plan put into effect by executive order according to the provisions of Ch. 144, SLA 1960, is \$900 but less than \$1,180 per month shall receive a pay increase in the amount of 4 per cent of the base salary he receives under the pay plan.

Sec. 4. The pay increases made by this Act are a percentage of base salary exclusive of area differentials.

Sec. 5. This Act takes effect July 1, 1961.
