SENATE BILL NO. 150

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the trapping of fur bearing animals; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. The State of Alaska shall pay any person, association, partnership or corporation a trapping incentive payment of 10% of the sale price of any fur bearing animal, as defined by the Department of Fish and Game, legally trapped in Alaska by said person, association, partnership or corporation. Payments shall be made by the Department of Administration upon claim filed in the manner prescribed by the department and verified by the commissioner of fish and game.

Sec. 2. Appropriations for carrying out the provisions of this Act are authorized and shall be set forth in the general appropriation bill or such other bills as may be necessary.

Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
