IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the leasing of space for state purposes, providing a time limitation; amending Sec. 8, Art. IV, Ch. 82, SLA 1955 as added by Ch. 81, SLA 1959; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 8, Art. IV of Ch. 82, SLA 1955 as added by Ch. 81, SLA 1959 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 8. LEASES. The Purchasing Agent is hereby authorized and directed to lease necessary space, and contract for the lease of space for the use of the state or any agency or branch thereof, wherever it is necessary and feasible; subject, however, to full compliance with the preceding requirements of this article; and provided that no such lease or contract for a lease shall provide for a period of occupancy greater than 20 years. Any agency, authority, branch, office, bureau or office of the state requiring office, warehouse or other space for state purposes and uses, shall lease such space solely through the Purchasing Agent.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
