SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to compensation rates under the Alaska Workmen's Compensation Act; and amending Secs. 5(3) and 8(5), Ch. 193, SLA 1959."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 5(3), Ch. 193, SLA 1959 is amended to read:

(3) In computing compensation for permanent total disability the average weekly wages shall be considered to have not been more than \$150.00 [\$81.00]; Provided, however, if the average weekly wages as computed under Section 9 are less than \$50.00 [\$18.00] per week he shall receive as compensation for permanent total disability his average weekly wages.

Sec. 2. Sec. 8(5), Ch. 193, SLA 1959 is amended to read:

(5) In computing death benefits the average weekly wages of the deceased shall be considered to have been not more than \$150.00 [\$81.00] nor less than \$50.00 [\$27.00] but the total weekly compensation shall not exceed the weekly wages of the deceased.
