SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to mining claims; repealing Secs. 47-3-87 and 47-3-89, ACLA 1949; amending Sec. 47-3-90, ACLA 1949; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Secs. 47-3-87 and 47-3-89, ACLA 1949, are hereby repealed.

Sec. 2. Sec. 47-3-90, ACLA 1949, is amended to read as follows:

§47-3-90. LOCATION OF CLAIMS BY AGENT OR ATTORNEY:
POWER OF ATTORNEY: FORM, ACKNOWLEDGMENT AND EXECUTION,
AND RECORDING: NUMBER OF PRINCIPALS AND CLAIMS. No person shall locate any placer mining claim in Alaska as agent or attorney for another unless he is duly authorized thereto by a power of attorney in writing, duly acknowledged and executed within four years prior to the date of location, and recorded in the office of the Recorder of the Recording District in which the claim is located. No person shall act as attorney in fact for more than two principals in any one recording district [; IF THE ATTORNEY IN FACT HAS TWO POWERS OF ATTORNEY HE MAY LOCATE ONE CLAIM UNDER EACH AND NO MORE, AND IF HE HAVE ONE POWER OF ATTORNEY, HE MAY LOCATE TWO CLAIMS THEREUNDER AND NO MORE DURING ANY ONE CALENDAR MONTH IN THE SAME RECORDING DISTRICT].

and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
