SENATE BILL NO. 179

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

SECOND LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the payment of travel and certain baggage expenses for members of the legislature; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Section 1, Ch. 36, SLA 1959, is amended to read:

Section 1. Each member of the Alaska State Legislature shall be entitled to receive one round trip first class airline fare, or its equivalent, from his place of residence in the election district from which elected or appointed to Juneau for purposes of attending regular, reconvened regular, or special sessions of the State Legislature. When needed, an excess baggage allowance of 100 pounds each way, or an air freight allowance not to exceed the cost of the maximum excess baggage allowance, is authorized [AN ALLOWANCE UP TO 50 POUNDS FOR EXCESS BAGGAGE EACH WAY IS HEREBY AUTHORIZED].
