BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Section 1, Ch. 36, SLA 1959, is amended to read:

12

Section 1. Each member of the Alaska State Legislature

13

shall be entitled to receive one round trip first class air-

14

line fare, or its equivalent, from his place of residence

15

in the election district from which elected or appointed to

16

Juneau for purposes of attending regular, reconvened regu-

17

lar, or special sessions of the State Legislature. When

18

needed, an excess baggage allowance of 50 pounds each way,

19

or an air freight allowance not to exceed the cost of the

20

maximum excess baggage allowance, is authorized [AN ALLOWANCE

21

UP TO 50 POUNDS FOR EXCESS BAGGAGE EACH WAY IS HEREBY

22

AUTHORIZED].

23

Section 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage

24

and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
