6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to motor vehicle license
7 taxes; amending Subsec. (1), Sec. 4, Ch.
8 124, SLA 1951 as last amended by Ch. 60,
9 SLA 1961; and providing an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 Section 1. Subsec. (1), Sec. 4, Ch. 124, SLA 1951, as
12 amended by Ch. 50, SLA 1953, Ch. 176, SLA 1957, Ch. 134, SLA 1959
13 and Ch. 60, SLA 1961 is amended to read:

14 (1) Levy and Rate of Tax. For the privilege of driving
15 or moving any vehicle subject to registration under this
16 Act upon any highway in the state there is hereby levied an
17 annual license tax. Such tax shall be at the rates speci-
18 fied in this section and shall be paid to and collected by
19 the department at the time of making application for regis-
20 tration, or annual renewal of registration, as provided
21 in this Act.

22 (a) For every motorcycle, \$10.00 [\$15.00].

23 (b) For every motor vehicle not designed, used,
24 or maintained primarily for the transportation of passengers
25 or property for hire, \$20.00 [\$30.00].

26 (c) For every motor vehicle for hire, operated
27 as and known as a taxicab, \$40.00 [\$50.00].

28 (d) For every motor vehicle, including motor
29 vehicles pulling trailers or semi-trailers, designed, used,

1 or maintained primarily for the transportation of passengers
2 for hire, excepting taxicabs, or for the transportation or
3 hauling of property, including, without limitation, such
4 commercial vehicles as trailers, semi-trailers, trucks,
5 wreckers, tow cars, hearses, ambulances, and tractors, the
6 actual unladen weight as established by the manufacturer's
7 advertised weight, or if not so determined, it shall be the
8 responsibility of the owner to furnish the true and actual
9 weight, subject to the approval of the commissioner or his
10 agent, of which is:

11 3,800 pounds or less.....\$25.00 [\$35.00]

12 3,801 pounds and not over

13 12,000 pounds.....\$50.00 [\$60.00]

14 Provided that motor buses of twenty or more seating
15 capacity used exclusively for commercial purposes in the
16 transporting of transient visitors and tourists shall be
17 included in this classification.

18 12,001 pounds and not over

19 18,000 pounds.....\$100.00 [\$110.00]

20 18,001 pounds and over.....\$150.00 [\$160.00]

21 (e) For any small two or four-wheeled trailer including,
22 but not limited to, boat trailers, small baggage trailers,
23 and house trailers, \$4.00.

24 (f) For every mobile amateur radio station for which
25 special registration plates are issued. The applicant
26 should pay an additional charge to cover the cost of the
27 special plates, as may be determined by the commissioner of
28 revenue at the time of registration.

29 Sec. 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 1963.
