IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

SECOND LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to Alaska lands and resources; amending Ch. 169, SLA 1959; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Subparagraph d. of Subsec. (4), Sec. 5, Art. III, Ch. 169, SLA 1959, is amended to read as follows:

d. The preference rights hereinabove granted any occupant in this subsection (4) shall be lost unless the occupant makes application to the Director to exercise such preference right by July 20, 1964 [WITHIN TWO YEARS FROM THE DATE THE DIRECTOR DETERMINES BY REGULATION THAT HE WILL ACCEPT APPLICATIONS FOR THE EXERCISE OF SUCH RESPECTIVE PREFERENCE RIGHTS].

Sec. 2. This Act shall take effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
