IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

SECOND LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to coin-operated devices; amending Sec. 48-3-2, ACLA 1949, as repealed and re-enacted by Ch. 142, SLA 1960; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 48-3-2, (2), ACLA 1949, as repealed and re-enacted by Sec. 2, Ch. 142, SLA 1960, is amended to read:

(2) "coin-operated device class 2" denotes any pinball machine, including any bingo type coin-operated devices, horse race machine, or any other apparatus or device which operates by means of insertion of a coin, token, or similar object and which, by embodying the elements of chance or skill, awards free plays in any manner and which contains a device for releasing such free plays and a meter for registering or recording the plays so released, or with a provision for multiple coin insertion for increasing the odds. Reimbursement of unredeemed plays may be made. The term does not include bona fide vending machines (in which ^{do} are not incorporated gaming or amusement features.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
