For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for change of address
7 of registered agents of business corpora-
8 tions; amending Sections 12 and 122 of
9 Ch. 126, SLA 1957; and providing for an
10 effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 12, Ch. 126, SLA 1957 is amended to read:

Sec. 12. CHANGE OF REGISTERED OFFICE OR REGISTERED

14

AGENT. (a) A corporation, domestic or foreign, may change

15

its registered office or change its registered agent, or

16

both, upon filing in the office of the commissioner of com-

17

merce [DIRECTOR OF FINANCE] a statement setting forth:

(1) [(a)] The name of the corporation.

(2) [(b)] The address of its then registered office.

(3) [(c)] If the address of its registered office be

21

changed, the address to which the registered office is to

22

be changed.

(4) [(d)] The name of its then registered agent.

24

(5) [(e)] If its registered agent be changed, the

25

name of its successor registered agent.

26

(6) [(f)] That the address of its registered office

27

and the address of the business office of its registered

28

agent, as changed, will be identical.

29

(7) [(g)] That such change was authorized by

1 resolution duly adopted by its board of directors.

2 (b) The [SUCH] statement in (a) of this section shall
3 be executed by the corporation by its president or a vice-
4 president, and verified by him, and delivered to the com-
5 missioner of commerce [DIRECTOR OF FINANCE]. If the com-
6 missioner of commerce [DIRECTOR OF FINANCE] finds that such
7 statement conforms to the provisions of this Act, he shall
8 file such statement in his office, and upon such filing
9 the change of address of the registered office, or the
10 appointment of a new registered agent, or both, as the
11 case may be, shall become effective.

12 (c) If the registered agent of a corporation, domestic
13 or foreign, changes the location of his office from one
14 address to another within a city or town, or from any city
15 or town in this state to any other city or town in this
16 state, he may change the registered office for each
17 corporation for whom he is acting as registered agent by
18 filing, in the office of the commissioner of commerce, a
19 statement setting forth:

20 (1) The name of the agent.

21 (2) The address of his office before change.

22 (3) The address to which the office is changed.

23 (4) List of corporations for whom he is furnishing a
24 registered office.

25 (d) The statement in (c) of this section shall be
26 executed by such registered agent in his individual name
27 and if such agent is a corporation, domestic or foreign,
28 it shall be executed by its president or a vice-president
29 and verified by him. The statement shall be delivered to

1 the commissioner of commerce and if he finds that such
2 statement conforms to the provisions of this chapter, he
3 shall file such statement in his office, and upon such
4 filing the change of the registered office for each of the
5 corporations named in such statement shall become effective
6 upon filing with the commissioner of commerce.

7 (e) Any registered agent of a corporation, domestic
8 or foreign, may resign as such agent upon filing a written
9 notice thereof, executed in duplicate, with the commissioner
10 of commerce [DIRECTOR OF FINANCE], who shall forthwith mail
11 a copy thereof to the corporation at its registered office.
12 The appointment of such agent shall terminate upon the
13 expiration of thirty days after receipt of such notice by
14 the commissioner of commerce [DIRECTOR OF FINANCE].

15 Sec. 2. Sec. 122, Ch. 126, SLA 1957 is amended to read:

16 Sec. 122. FEES ON APPOINTMENT OR REVOCATION OF
17 APPOINTMENT OF PROCESS AGENT. (a) Every foreign corpora-
18 tion filing in the office of the commissioner of commerce
19 [DIRECTOR OF FINANCE] a certificate of the appointment and
20 consent of the agent residing in Alaska, or a certificate or
21 revocation of such appointment of the resident agent, shall
22 pay to the commissioner of commerce [DIRECTOR OF FINANCE]
23 a fee of five dollars.

24 (b) For filing a statement mentioned in Sec. 12(c)
25 and (d) of change of address of registered agent, the agent
26 shall pay to the commissioner of commerce a fee of twenty-
27 five dollars.

28 Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
29 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
