SENATE BILL NO. 234

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

SECOND LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the licensing of
cigarette vending machine operators;
amending Ch. 187, SLA 1955."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 4, Ch. 187, SLA 1955, is amended to read:

Section 4. SEPARATE LICENSES. Where a person operates more than one place of business, whether temporary or established, the person must obtain a separate license for each such place of business. [: PROVIDED, THAT A PERSON OPERATING ONE OR MORE CIGARETTE VENDING MACHINES SHALL BE DEEMED TO HAVE ONLY ONE PLACE OF BUSINESS FOR LICENSING PURPOSES.]

Any person licensed only as a manufacturer, distributor, direct-buying retailer, vending machine operator, or buyer [,] shall not operate in any other capacity except that for which he is licensed unless the appropriate license or licenses therefor are first secured. Each license shall be exhibited at the place of business for which it is issued and in such manner as may be prescribed by the Commissioner.

Sec. 2. Sec. 5, Ch. 187, SLA 1955, is amended to read:

Section 5. LICENSE FEES. For each license issued to a manufacturer, and for each renewal therefor, there shall be paid to the Commissioner a fee of \$5.

For each license issued to a distributor and for each renewal therefor, there shall be paid to the Commissioner a

1 fee of \$50.

2 For each license issued to a vending machine operator,
3 and for each renewal therefor, there shall be paid to the
4 Commissioner a fee of \$60 per machine if the use of the
5 machine is under the constant observation of the vending
6 machine operator or owner, or an employee or agent of the
7 operator or owner. If the use of a machine is not under
8 the constant observation of the vending machine operator
9 or owner, or an employee or agent of the operator or owner,
10 the fee is \$150 per machine [\$25].

11 For each license issued to a direct-buying retailer,
12 and for each renewal therefor, there shall be paid to the
13 Commissioner a fee of \$25.

14 For each license issued to a buyer, and for each re-
15 newal therefor, there shall be paid to the Commissioner a
16 fee of \$25.

17 No license shall be issued to any person except upon
18 the payment of the fee therefor, any statute or exemption
19 to the contrary notwithstanding.
