6 For an Act entitled: "An Act prohibiting the use of X-rays by
7 chiropractors; and amending Sec. 35-3-22,
8 ACLA 1949."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 Section 1. Sec. 35-3-22, ACLA 1949, is amended to read:

11 Sec. 35-3-22. CHIROPRACTIC DEFINED. Chiropractic is
12 defined as the science of locating and correcting inter-
13 ference with nerve energy transmission and expression within
14 the human body, and the employment and practice of Drugless
15 Therapeutics, including Physiotherapy, Hydrotherapy,
16 Mechanotherapy, Phytotherapy, Electrotherapy, Chromotherapy,
17 Thermotherapy, Thalmotherapy, corrective and Orthopedic
18 Gymnastics and Dietetics which shall consist of and include
19 the use of foods and such Biochemical tissue building
20 products and Cell Salts as are found within the normal human
21 body, without the use of drugs or surgery or the use of
22 X-rays to photograph, examine, diagnose or treat patients.
