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A BILL

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For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the annual corporation  
7 tax and annual report filing fee; amending  
8 Sec. 123, SLA 1957; and repealing Sec. 136,  
9 Ch. 126, SLA 1957."

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

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Section 1. Sec. 123, Ch. 126, SLA 1957, is amended to read:

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Sec. 123. ANNUAL CORPORATION TAX: PENALTY FOR NON-

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PAYMENT. Every corporation incorporated under the laws of

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Alaska and every foreign corporation having its articles

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of incorporation on file in the office of the commissioner

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of commerce [DIRECTOR OF FINANCE], shall, on or before the

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fifteenth day of February [FIRST DAY OF JANUARY] of each and

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every year, pay to the commissioner of commerce [DIRECTOR OF

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FINANCE, FOR THE USE OF ALASKA], an annual corporation tax of

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\$25 if a domestic corporation or \$50 if a foreign corporation

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[FIFTEEN DOLLARS]. Every corporation which has failed or

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hereafter fails to pay said annual corporation tax on or before

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the fifteenth day of February [FIRST DAY OF JANUARY] of each

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and every year, shall pay to the commissioner of commerce

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[DIRECTOR OF FINANCE, FOR THE USE OF ALASKA], in addition to

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the said annual corporation tax, the further sum of 2.50

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[TWO DOLLARS AND FIFTY CENTS] as a penalty for such failure.

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Corporations organized under Section 36-6-4, ACLA 1949

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shall not be required to pay such annual corporation tax.

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Sec. 2. Sec. 136, Ch. 126, SLA 1957, is repealed.
