12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

13 Section 1. Subsec. (16), Sec. 2, Art. II, Ch. 94, SLA 1959,
14 as amended by Sec. 1, Ch. 96, SLA 1959 and Sec. 13, Ch. 131, SLA
15 1960, is amended to read:

16 (16) Non-resident big game tags:

17	Brown or grizzly bear ...Each.....	\$ 75.00
18	Polar bear.....Each	<u>\$1500.00</u> [150.00]
19	Black bear, deer.....Each.....	10.00
20	Bison, moose, sheep.....Each.....	50.00
21	Walrus.....Each.....	100.00
22	Elks, goats, caribou.....Each.....	25.00

23 Provided, that the Commissioner may issue to
24 any person without cost permits to collect
25 fish and game, subject to such limitations
26 and provisions as he deems appropriate, for
27 scientific, propagative, or educational pur-
28 poses; and provided further, that tags issued
29 but not used for animals specified above,

may be utilized to satisfy the tagging requirements for any of the species above named of which the tag fee is of equal or less evaluation, but only for the year in which the tag is issued.
