For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to a curfew for minors; and
7 providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. The provisions of any curfew ordinance enacted
10 by a city of any class concerning minors shall be imposed in the
11 total area within 20 miles of the limits of that city. In the
12 event a given area lies within 20 miles of two or more cities
13 with conflicting curfew ordinances the provisions of the curfew
14 ordinance of the city having the largest population shall prevail
15 as to that overlapping area.

Sec. 2. The penalty for violation of this Act shall be as
17 prescribed by the curfew ordinance of the city and any fine so
18 paid shall be paid to the city when the violation takes place
19 therein, or shall otherwise be paid to the state; provided, how-
20 ever, that the penalty shall not exceed a fine of \$300 or imprison-
21 ment for 30 days, or both.

Sec. 3. The municipal peace officers shall enforce the pro-
23 visions of the ordinance inside the city limits, and, under the
24 provisions of this Act, the state peace officers shall enforce the
25 provisions of the ordinance in the area outside the city limits.
26 In areas where state peace officers are not available, the muni-
27 cipal peace officers shall be authorized to enforce the provisions
28 of the ordinance in the area outside the city limits, when such
29 enforcement responsibilities are delegated by contract between the

1 state and the municipality.

2 Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
3 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
