5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to a curfew for minors; and
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 Section 1. The provisions of any curfew ordinance enacted
10 by a city or village of any class concerning minors shall be
11 imposed in the total area within 20 miles of the limits of that
12 city or village. In the event a given area lies within 20 miles
13 of two or more cities with conflicting curfew ordinances the
14 provisions of the curfew ordinance of the city having the largest
15 population shall prevail as to that overlapping area.

16 Sec. 2. The penalty for violation of this Act shall be as
17 prescribed by the curfew ordinance of the city and any fine so
18 paid shall be paid to the city when the violation takes place
19 therein, or shall otherwise be paid to the state; provided, however,
20 that the penalty shall not exceed a fine of \$300 or imprisonment
21 for 30 days, or both.

22 Sec. 3. The municipal peace officers shall enforce the pro-
23 visions of the ordinance inside the city limits, and, under the
24 provisions of this Act, the state peace officers shall enforce the
25 provisions of the ordinance in the area outside the city limits.
26 In areas where state peace officers are not available, the munici-
27 pal peace officers shall be authorized to enforce the provisions
28 of the ordinance in the area outside the city limits, when such
29 enforcement responsibilities are delegated by contract between the

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1 state and the municipality.

2 Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
3 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
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
