IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
SECOND LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Cigarette Tax Act;
amending Sec. 10, Ch. 187, SLA 1955; and
providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 10, Ch. 187, SLA 1955 is amended to read:

Every licensee shall, on or before the last [15TH] day
of each calendar month, file with the Commissioner, on a
form prescribed by the Commissioner, a return, under the
penalties of perjury, for each place of business maintained.
The return shall state the number of cigarettes manufactured,
imported, or acquired, from any source whatever by such
licensee during the preceding calendar month, and such
return shall contain or be accompanied by such other infor-
mation as the Commissioner may require. If a licensee
ceases to import or acquire cigarettes, he shall forthwith
file with the Commissioner such a return for the period
ending with such cessation.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect April 1, 1962.
