SECOND LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to minimum wages; amending Sec 2, Ch. 171, SLA 1959; amending Sec. 4, Ch. 171, SLA 1959, as amended by Ch. 2, SLA 1962; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Subsec. (1)(1), Sec. 2, Ch. 171, SLA 1959, is amended to read:

(1) any individual employed in a bona fide executive, administrative or professional capacity or in the capacity of an outside salesman, or any salesman or individual who is employed on a straight commission basis;

Sec. 2. Sec. 4, Ch. 171, SLA 1959, as amended by Sec. 2, Ch. 2, SLA 1962, is amended to read:

Sec. 4. MINIMUM WAGES. Every employer, except as may be otherwise provided in this Act, shall pay to each of his employees wages at a rate of not less than 30 per cent [\$.50] an hour greater than the prevailing Federal Minimum Wage Law.

Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
