10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:  
11 Section 1. Subsec. (1) (1), Sec. 2, Ch. 171, SLA 1959, is  
12 amended to read:  
13 (1) any individual employed in a bona fide  
14 executive, administrative or professional capacity or in  
15 the capacity of an outside salesman, or any salesman or  
16 individual who is employed on a straight commission basis;  
17 Sec. 2. Sec. 2, Ch. 171, SLA 1959, is amended by adding a  
18 new Subsec. (1) to read as follows:  
19 (1) any employee of a non-profit hospital.  
20 Sec. 3. Sec. 4, Ch. 171, SLA 1959, as amended by Sec. 2,  
21 Ch. 2, SLA 1962, is amended to read:  
22 Sec. 4. MINIMUM WAGES. Every employer, except as may  
23 be otherwise provided in this Act, shall pay to each of his  
24 employees wages at a rate of not less than 35 per cent [\$.50]  
25 an hour greater than the prevailing Federal Minimum Wage Law.  
26 Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage  
27 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
