SECOND LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the practice of barbering; amending Ch. 68, SLA 1957, as last amended by Ch. 168, SLA 1960."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Ch. 68, SLA 1957, as last amended by Ch. 168, SLA 1960, is amended by adding a new article to read:

Article VI

APPRENTICE BARBERS

Section 1. Before a person is entitled to be licensed as a barber he must be licensed as an apprentice barber.

Sec. 2. To be entitled to be licensed as an apprentice barber a person must have

(1) educational requirements specified by this Act or by regulations of the board;

(2) completed a course of study and training in, and received a diploma from, an approved barber college in the state;

(3) applied to the board for an examination within six months from the date of graduation from the approved barber college; and

(4) passed an examination given by the board.

Sec. 3. An applicant who fails an examination or fails to apply for an examination within six months of the time he graduates from an approved barber college must re-enroll

in an approved barber college and pass further courses specified by the board.

Sec. 4. An apprentice barber is entitled to take an examination, prescribed by the board, and, if he passes it, to be licensed as a barber after he has served as an apprentice barber for eight hours a day, five days a week, for two years. If he fails the examination, he must practice as an apprentice barber for six months before he may apply for another examination.

Sec. 5. An apprentice barber shall file an affidavit with the board at the end of each six months for a two-year period from the date he is licensed as an apprentice. The affidavit must be signed by a licensed barber, and must certify that the applicant has worked as an apprentice barber for eight hours a day, five days a week for six months. The board may revoke or suspend the license of a licensed barber who refuses to sign a true affidavit, and may sign the affidavit in the place of the barber. An apprentice who does not file the affidavit may not take an examination.

Sec. 2. Ch. 68, SLA 1957, as last amended by Ch. 168, SLA 1960, is amended by adding a new article to read:

Article VII

LICENSE TO CONDUCT BARBER SHOP

Section 1. No person may own or operate a barber shop the operation of which begins after the effective date of this Act without having been inspected and licensed by the board.

Sec. 2. No barber shop may be licensed until it complies with the requirements of this Act and the regulations

2 Sec. 3. Barber shop licenses are not transferable from  
3 person to person or from location to location.

4 Sec. 4. No license to operate a barber shop may be  
5 issued for at least a reasonable time after application is  
6 made for it.
