6 For an Act entitled: "An Act protecting the public safety and
7 morals; and providing for an effective
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 Section 1. Sec. 4, Ch. 187, SLA 1955, is amended to read:

11 Section 4. SEPARATE LICENSES. Where a person operates
12 more than one place of business, whether temporary or esta-
13 lished, the person must obtain a separate license for each
14 such place of business. [: PROVIDED, THAT A PERSON OPERATING
15 ONE OR MORE CIGARETTE VENDING MACHINES SHALL BE DEEMED TO
16 HAVE ONLY ONE PLACE OF BUSINESS FOR LICENSING PURPOSES.]

17 Any person licensed only as a manufacturer, distributor,
18 direct-buying retailer, vending machine operator, or buyer
19 [,] shall not operate in any other capacity except that for
20 which he is licensed unless the appropriate license or
21 licenses therefor are first secured. Each license shall be
22 exhibited at the place of business for which it is issued
23 and in such manner as may be prescribed by the Commissioner.

24 Sec. 2. Sec. 5, Ch. 187, SLA 1955, is amended by adding a
25 new paragraph to read:

26 All cigarette vending machines will be equipped with an
27 electric device which will allow for remote control of the
28 operation of the machine by the owner or operator of the
29 establishment in which the machine is located. This control

device is not required of machines located in premises in which minors are not allowed.

Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on January 1, 1963.
