SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 7

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

Relating to a feasibility study  
for the establishment of a non-  
profit exclusive state workmen's  
compensation fund.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, FIRST SESSION  
ASSEMBLED, THE HOUSE CONCURRING:

WHEREAS, the Legislature now has before it Senate Bill No.  
80 and House Bill No. 209, which provide for the creation of a  
non-profit exclusive state workmen's compensation fund; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature is cognizant of the desirability  
and need of having public hearings on the subject before it can  
take appropriate action;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate in Second Legislature, First  
Session assembled, the House concurring, that the Legislative  
Council and the Commissioners of Commerce and Labor hold public  
hearings on the subject of a non-profit exclusive state fund and  
Workmen's Compensation Insurance premium rates now in effect and  
in conjunction with the Legislative Council report their findings  
to the Second Legislature, Second Session, on the day it convenes.
