SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 7

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

Relating to the establishment of  
a non-profit exclusive state  
workmen's compensation fund.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, FIRST SESSION  
ASSEMBLED, THE HOUSE CONCURRING:

WHEREAS, the Legislature now has before it Senate Bill No.  
80, which provides for the creation of a non-profit exclusive  
state workmen's compensation fund; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature is cognizant of the desirability  
and need of having public hearings on the subject before it can  
take appropriate action;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate in Second Legislature, First  
Session assembled, the House concurring, that the Commissioners  
of Commerce and Labor hold public hearings on the subject of a  
non-profit exclusive state fund and Workmen's Compensation  
Insurance premium rates now in effect in conjunction with the  
Legislative Council and report their findings to the Second  
Legislature, Second Session, on the day it convenes.
