2 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 8
3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
4 SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to the dredging of a channel
6 between the city of Cordova and the sea.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, FIRST SESSION
8 ASSEMBLED, THE HOUSE CONCURRING:

9 WHEREAS, the city of Cordova is a city whose development is
10 largely dependent upon access to the sea; and

11 WHEREAS, the present mode of access, through the Copper River
12 flats is inadequate, due to sandbars and other obstructions and
13 is in need of clearing and deepening to develop the full economic
14 potential of Cordova; and

15 WHEREAS, it is understood that the U. S. Army Corps of
16 Engineers is charged with the function of surveying and dredging
17 access channels;

18 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate, in Second Legislature, First
19 Session assembled, the House of Representative concurring that the
20 U. S. Army corps of Engineer is urged to take the proper steps in
21 the spring of 1961 necessary to survey and dredge the channel
22 between Cordova and the sea through the Copper River flats as a
23 means to clearing the channel and deepening it; and be it

24 FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be directed
25 to the Honorable Elvis J. Stahr, Secretary of the Army; Colonel
26 Christian Hanburger, District Engineer, Corps of Engineers, U. S.
27 Army; and the Alaska delegation in Congress.

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
