5 Review and revision of laws relating
6 to licensing of insurance agents and
7 brokers.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, FIRST SESSION
9 ASSEMBLED, THE HOUSE CONCURRING:

10 WHEREAS, the licensing and regulation of insurance companies
11 and their agents and of independent insurance brokers and surplus
12 line brokers in the public interest has been a function of Alaska
13 as a territory and as a state; and

14 WHEREAS, the advent of statehood and the increasing volume
15 of insurance transactions have made apparent the need for a re-
16 vision and clarification of the law on the subject in order that
17 it may meet the standards set by Congress in Public Law No. 15 of
18 1945;

19 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate in Second Legislature, First
20 Session assembled, the House of Representatives concurring, that
21 the Commissioner of the Department of Commerce be and hereby is
22 requested to review the existing laws on the licensing and regu-
23 lation of insurance companies and their agents, independent insur-
24 ance brokers, and surplus line brokers, and submit his findings
25 and suggested legislation as reviewed by the Attorney General to
26 the Legislative Council on or by November 15, 1961 for its review
27 and subsequent transmission with comments to the Legislature on or
28 by the day it convenes for its regular session in January 1962.
