SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 11
IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

Relating to the time limit on transmission of bills between houses.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, FIRST SESSION ASSEMBLED, THE HOUSE CONCURRING:

WHEREAS, under provisions of Uniform Rule 64 bills may not be received in one house from the other house after the fiftieth day of any regular session except those bills introduced by standing committees; and

WHEREAS, it now appears advisable to extend the time limit for transmission of bills between the House and the Senate; and

WHEREAS, the time limit set forth in Uniform Rule 64 may be changed by approval of a concurrent resolution by a two-thirds vote in the affirmative of the membership to which each house is entitled;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate in Second Legislature, First Session assembled, the House concurring, that the time limit on transmission of bills between the houses during the current session be changed to allow transmission beyond the fiftieth legislative day.
