5 Relating to the time limit on trans-
6 mission of bills between houses.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, FIRST SESSION
8 ASSEMBLED, THE HOUSE CONCURRING:

9 WHEREAS, under provisions of Uniform Rule 64 bills may not
10 be received in one house from the other house after the fiftieth
11 day of any regular session except those bills introduced by
12 standing committees; and

13 WHEREAS, it now appears advisable to extend the time limit
14 for transmission of bills between the House and the Senate; and

15 WHEREAS, the time limit set forth in Uniform Rule 64 may be
16 changed by approval of a concurrent resolution by a two-thirds
17 vote in the affirmative of the membership to which each house is
18 entitled;

19 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate in Second Legislature, First
20 Session assembled, the House concurring, that the time limit on
21 transmission of bills between the houses during the current
22 session be changed to allow transmission until midnight of the
23 fifty-ninth day.
