SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 13  
IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA  
SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

Relating to a study of jurisdiction  
and punishment of juveniles accused  
of felonies.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA IN SECOND  
LEGISLATURE, FIRST SESSION ASSEMBLED, THE HOUSE CONCURRING:

WHEREAS, the Alaska Legislative Council is a permanent  
interim committee and service agency of the legislature, designed  
to provide assistance in the development of sound legislation in  
the public interest; and

WHEREAS, the present laws concerning juveniles accused of  
felonies may require revision;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate in Second Legislature, First  
Session assembled, the House of Representatives concurring, that  
the Alaska Legislative Council be directed to undertake a study  
of the present laws pertaining to jurisdiction and punishment of  
juveniles accused of felonies and of the necessity for a revised  
up-to-date juvenile code covering all juvenile laws, and to  
prepare recommendations concerning revisions found to be needed.
