5 Relating to the extension of "C" Street  
6 south of Anchorage to International  
7 Airport Road.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION  
9 ASSEMBLED, THE HOUSE CONCURRING:

10 WHEREAS, the extension of "C" Street south of Anchorage to  
11 International Airport Road would provide a third and more direct  
12 traffic route out of Anchorage to International Airport Road and  
13 the residential area south of the city, affording early relief of  
14 the Anchorage area's traffic congestion at a fraction of the cost  
15 of a freeway system; and

16 WHEREAS, the extension of "C" Street as part of the state  
17 highway system would open for development the large area of idle  
18 land between the end of "C" Street and International Airport Road,  
19 an area of land that comprises about 15 percent of the total area  
20 of the Spenard Public Utility District No. 1, expanding the  
21 District's economy and broadening its tax base;

22 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate in Second Legislature, Second  
23 Session assembled, the House of Representatives concurring, that  
24 the Honorable William A. Egan, Governor of Alaska, be respectfully  
25 urged to direct the Division of Highways, Department of Public  
26 Works, to investigate, study, and then program for the acquisition  
27 of the necessary rights-of-way and the construction of the exten-  
28 sion of "C" Street south of Anchorage to International Airport  
29 Road as a part of the state highway system.
