SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 18
IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
SECOND LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION
Relating to employees on the
State Ferry System.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, SECOND
SESSION ASSEMBLED, THE HOUSE CONCURRING:

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska, because of its long-standing
fishing industry and its intimate connection with marine trans-
portation, has many residents who are eminently qualified to
operate all kinds of water craft; and

WHEREAS, residents of Alaska bear most of the tax burden
necessary to pay state employees; and

WHEREAS, employees of the State Ferry System to be in-
augurated in September, 1962, will be state employees whose
salaries will be paid through the state by the residents of
Alaska;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate in Second Legislature, Second
Session assembled, the House of Representatives concurring,
that the Honorable William A. Egan, Governor of Alaska, be
respectfully requested to direct the Division of Marine Trans-
portation, Department of Public Works, to give strict preference
to qualified residents of the State of Alaska who apply for
positions of employment on state ferries and docking facilities.
