7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, SECOND
8 SESSION ASSEMBLED, THE HOUSE CONCURRING:

9 WHEREAS, death has taken from our midst a distinguished
10 Alaska citizen, the Honorable Julien A. Hurley; and

11 WHEREAS, Mr. Hurley came to Alaska in January of 1922 as
12 assistant United States Attorney for the Third Division of Alaska,
13 was appointed by President Harding as United States Attorney for
14 the Fourth Division at Fairbanks in July of 1924, and served
15 until 1933; and

16 WHEREAS, he served as a distinguished member of the House of
17 Representatives of the Alaska Territorial Legislature in 1953,
18 having previously had, in 1917, the distinction of being the
19 youngest senator to be elected to the Oregon State Senate at
20 that time; and

21 WHEREAS, his career as a brilliant lawyer was characterized
22 by a deep concern for the constitutional rights of those he
23 prosecuted or defended in the name of Justice;

24 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate in Second Legislature, Second
25 Session assembled, the House of Representatives concurring, that
26 this resolution serve as an expression of the high esteem of the
27 members of the Legislature for the late Julien A. Hurley, and
28 as a means of conveying to Mrs. Julien A. Hurley their sincere
29 condolences and best wishes.
