SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 21

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

SECOND LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Relating to an amendment to the
Uniform Rules concerning legis-
lative changes to supreme court
rules of practice and procedure.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION
ASSEMBLED, THE HOUSE CONCURRING, that Rule 48 of the Uniform Rules
of the Legislature is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

A bill or portion of a bill which if passed would result in
changes to a supreme court rule of practice or procedure is not
effective to change the court rule unless the bill (1) receives
a two-thirds vote of the members of each house, and (2) contains
a section stating that a rule change is the purpose of the bill
or a part of the bill; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that Rule 47 of the Uniform Rules of the
Legislature is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

If a bill contains a section which states that the bill
changes a supreme court rule of practice or procedure fails to
receive a two-thirds vote of the members of each house, the
engrossing clerk of the house in which the bill originated shall
delete that section from the bill before it is engrossed.
